

## Scholarship of Shanghai Municipal Government

Excellent applicant of degree program has the opportunity to receive the Scholarship of Shanghai Municipal Government, the specific requirements are as follows:

### 1. Scholarship Program

Four-Year Undergraduate Program (taught in Chinese)

### 2. Scholarship Category

(1) Scholarship of Shanghai Municipal Government is divided into Category A and Category B.

(2) Scholarship Coverage:

Category A covers tuition fees, accommodation fees, living expenses, and medical insurance fees;

Category B covers tuition fees and medical insurance fees.

### 3. Admission Qualifications and Application

#### (1) Entry Requirements

1) Citizenship

Students applying for Scholarship of Shanghai Municipal Government must be non-Chinese citizens.

2) Age and Education

Applicants should have a high school education or above and be under the age of 25.

3) Language Ability

Applicants should reach Chinese HSK level 4 or above, and meet the language requirements of the college to which they are applying.

#### (2) Application Requirements

Students can log on to the website "Study in Shanghai" (<http://study.shmec.gov.cn/>), which provides information about universities, courses, application deadlines and processes, and students can apply for scholarships online.

Students also need to download the form from SUMHS's admissions website <https://iec.sumhs.edu.cn/>, and send an email to the email address provided.

If you want to live in campus, please indicate in the application form. The university will arrange rooms according to your application time and vacancies, and make some adjustments if necessary.

2) Copy of Passport

A copy of a valid passport page, including the passport photo, name, date of birth, passport validity period, and passport number.

If you are already in China, please provide a valid visa copy.

3) High school diploma

- 4) Full transcript of high school
- 5) HSK level 4 or above Chinese proficiency certificate
- 6) Recommendation letter
- 7) Financial status certification documents
- 8) If the applicant's place of birth is China, the following copies should be provided: certificate of naturalization, certificate of cancellation of the original Chinese household registration, proof of actual residence abroad in the past four years (if the original is in other languages, a notarized original copy in Chinese or English is required)

Note: ① Documents issued in other languages must be notarized and translated into Chinese or English.

② Applicants under the age of 18 should provide a letter of guarantee from the guardian

### **(3) Application period: December to May 30**

#### **4. Annual Review Regulations**

SUMHS Shanghai Government Scholarship Review Committee will evaluate the student's comprehensive grades, learning attitude, attendance, behavior, rewards and punishments every year. International students who pass the review are eligible to keep the scholarship for the next year, and those who fail the review will be suspended or disqualified their eligibility to have the scholarship for the next year.
